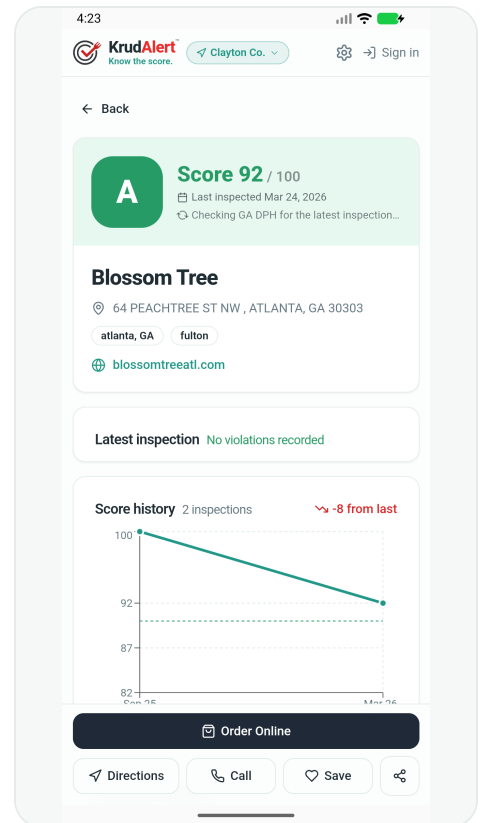
THE OPPORTUNITY
